




LOGLINE

In an act of desperation, a grief-stricken man captures lightning in a jar, and by doing so, locks away his past with it.



SYNOPSIS

Ben has done it: he has captured lightning in a jar. After having disappeared for some time, Ben describes to his friend Elena what it took for him to accomplish this—that the act forced him to lock away a part of himself in the jar with the lightning. Elena sees that due to the trauma of his father's death, Ben is living an alternative reality, that he's abandoned himself as a result of his profound grief. For every time Elena touches the lightning, she gets a glimpse of Ben's past. Elena is faced with a decision to either allow Ben to continue being consumed by his emotional distress or to help rid him of this escapism.

DIRECTOR STATEMENT

I've always been obsessed with lightning storms and the idea of fictionally harnessing their incredible power in a story. I wondered what it would actually take to complete such a sublime feat; I came to the personal conclusion that in order to catch a bolt of lightning, you'd have to tie a piece of yourself to it. LIGHTNING'S ECHO is about the hidden pieces of our lives that we choose not to share with people; how grief or depression or anxiety can manifest itself in so many potentially destructive ways. That we're all facing our own challenges with a need to be held and understood. In the short, we find Ben has done this...locked away any kind of grief, to completely escape the cold and isolation he felt that came with it. When I started pitching the short to my different crew members, the idea of concealment resonated with many of them. I feel that most human beings are always concealing something, and this is my attempt to artistically depict that concealment. I hope you enjoy the short!
